Job description

- Conduct a systematic literature research on academic articles about COVID-19-related artwork and draft a summary of the literature results
- Depending on qualification: lead or coordinate the writing of an academic article about the 19and.ART findings under the supervision of the 19and.ART investigators; co-authorship possible
- Researching YouTube for non-verbal educational videos about COVID-19 (to be collected on a 19and.ART YouTube channel)
- Researching major newspapers globally for caricature art (to be collected on the www.19and.ART website)
- Reaching out to major newspapers globally to ask if copyright for re-use of caricature art can be granted
- Contacting National Young Academy members worldwide to submit educational videos and/or caricature art for inclusion in 19and.ART project
- Regular discussion with 19and.ART co-investigators on progress

Job requirements

- Academic background (BS) in the arts, communication, communications design or similar
- Fluent command of English, including academic writing skills
- Experience with academic writing, in particular (systematic) literature reviews
- Experience with literature search in academic databases
- International interest and experience, intercultural sensitivity and competencies, good written and verbal communication skills, creativity, good presentation and self-organisation
