Major Scientific Interests

Structure and function of the outer and inner membrane of gram-negative bacteria. Import and export of metabolites and of protein toxins. Genetic mechanisms leading to the formation of the protein toxin variety. Mechanisms of the iron supply of bacteria. Regulation of iron transport and its implication for the virulence of pathogenic bacteria. Transmembrane-transcription control. Mechanisms of signal initiation, recognition, transfer, and response.
